GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. MUTILATION OF FORM

Avoid improper handling of the application form such as folding, crumbling, ruling lines or making unnecessary marks on the forms. Mutilated forms and forms with irrelevant marks will be rejected.

2. USE OF INK

Complete the sheets in ink. Use block letters in filling all the sections in the form.

3. PHOTOGRAPH

Applicant must enclose **Two passport-size photographs** [Standard size] on **white background** which must be affixed on the form. One of the photographs must have the Applicants First choice programme of study and should be endorsed by a person of high repute.

COMPLETING THE VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE FORMS

A. PERSONAL DETAILS

Applicants write full name as it appears on their certificates; surname first followed by other names. If you have compound name use hyphen (-) to link the two names. If your name is longer than the space provided do not use initials but attempt to write full name and stop where you exhaust all the space provided. If you were using a name initially which is on your previous certificates or results slips, provide it in the space provided and attach copies of affidavit with other documents of proof.

B. PARTICULARS OF PARENT, GUARDIAN / GUARANTOR

Applicants write full name of parent, guardian who will sponsor financially the full course fees if applicant is admitted. He/ she must provide full information in the spaces provided.

C. EDUCATIONAL RECORD (*Start with most recent or current institution*)

Provided information on the institutions you've attended starting with the most recent/current, month and year of completion, Index number, centre where you took the examinations, field / course of studied and the type of examination e.g. SSSCE, WASSCE, NVTI etc.

D. HISTORY OF EXAMINATION

Applicant is expected to list all subjects taken (passed or failed) in chronological order.
